The [International Coach Federation](#) is the only global as well as the largest credentialing institution.

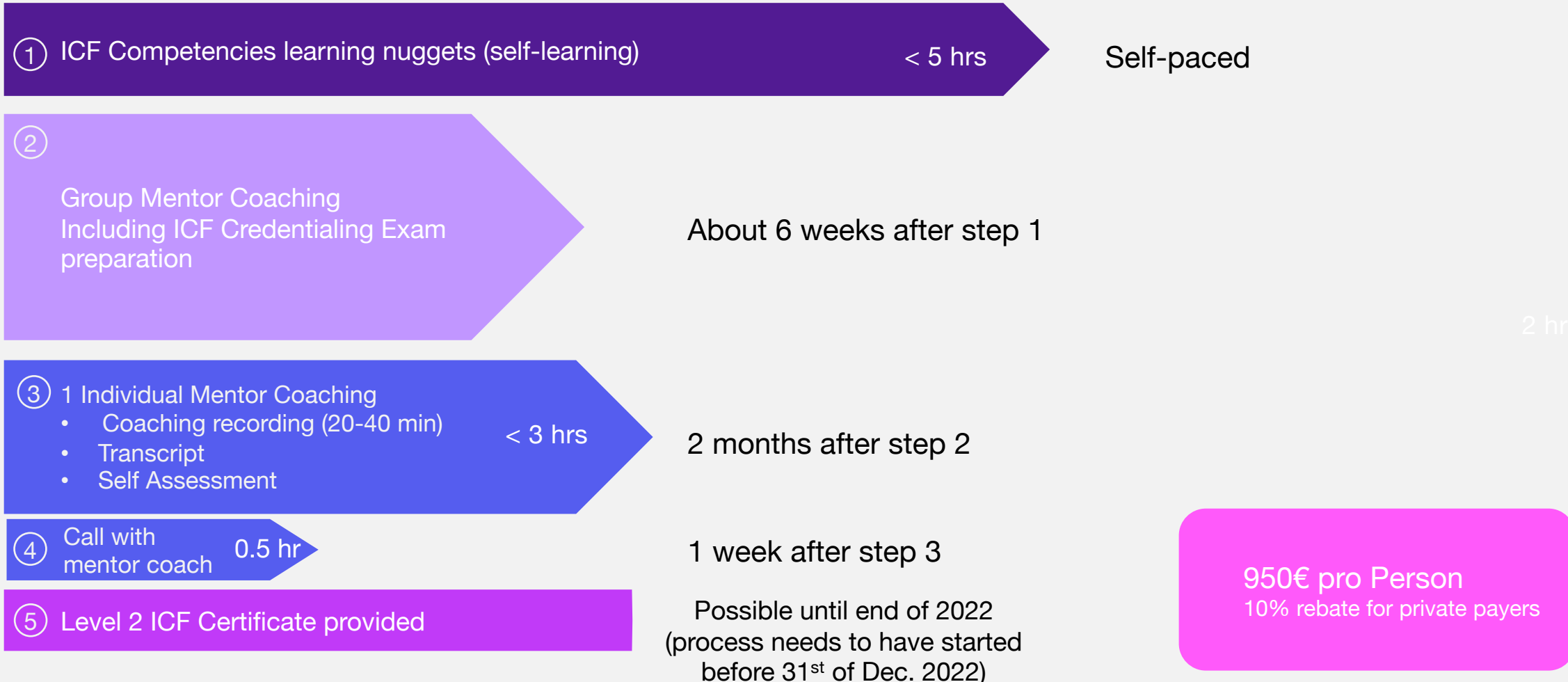
If you have a previous non-ICF coach training and you want to get an internationally recognized degree, you can transition until the 31st of December 2022

We will acknowledge your previous training, which means the needed coaching hours for an ACC (100hrs) or PCC (500 hrs) credential count from day 1 of your first training onwards.

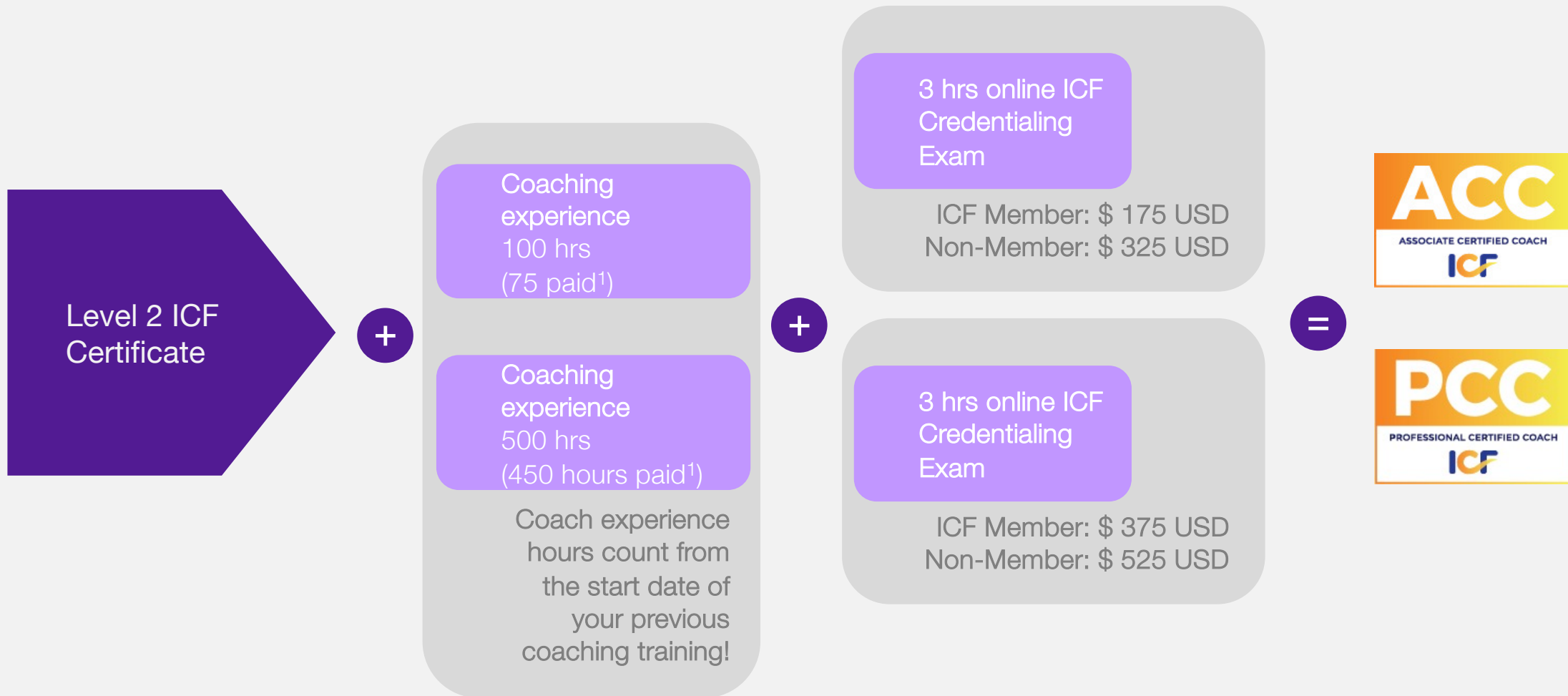
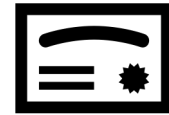


Upgrade to PPC and ICF Certification

A maximum of 10 hrs to a PCC-Level diploma for skilled coaches

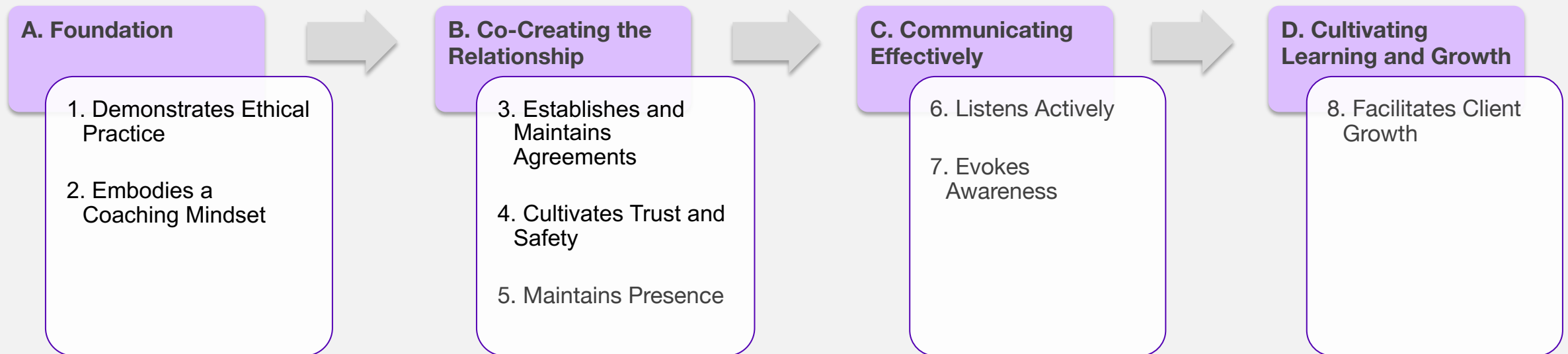


Your Level 2 diploma allows for ACC and/ or PCC credential



1) 450 hours paid (Paid: salary, barter deals and low payment), 25 clients min. 50 hours must have occurred within the 18 months prior to submitting the credential application. At least 450 of the hours must be paid.
2) Retake costs 105 US\$ with ICF
